Marine Genus Biodiversity: Extinction Intensity






Northern Corroboree frog
Its breeding sites are vulnerable to feral pigs and horses. Under attack from the chytrid fungus disease which is exacerbated by climate change


Ganges river dolphin
Suffering as the river experiences damming, overfishing, chronic pollution and excessive drainage for irrigation projects

Freshwater 29% of species lost in the past 35 years



Cormorant
Up to two-thirds of chicks are killed when their meadow habitats are mown, because the baby birds are reluctant to leave tall grass

Male Indian Gharial
The rivers where these alligators live have been dammed and diverted for irrigation, and unlike many fellow reptiles they cannot walk overland in search of more
